Once the products are loaded, and my route has been planned, I will drive to various customer premises and projects across the south of England. On average, I'll probably make around 8 deliveries per day. I really enjoy getting out and about, driving to different places and meeting new people.

Driving a large vehicle obviously comes with great responsibility. Covers keep us updated with our CPC training every year and supply us with Health and Safety equipment.
